Authorized Wildlife

Authorized to possess sick, injured, orphaned, or otherwise impaired wildlife native to the state of Florida for rehabilitation purposes. Not authorized to possess Class I animals, Class II animals, venomous reptiles, non-venomous reptiles, raccoons, foxes, otters, beavers, or bats unless specifically authorized below.

Permit Conditions

- RNW-G #1 Wildlife maintained under this permit at this facility shall be subject to inspection by Commission personnel, pursuant to Section 379.304, F.S., and Rule 68A-4.006, F.A.C.
 - RNW-G #2 All wildlife possessed under the authority of this permit shall remain the property of the State of Florida and under the primary jurisdiction of the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC).
 - RNW-G #3 A rehabilitation permit issued by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service is required to possess migratory birds for rehabilitation purposes.
 - RNW-G #4 Care, disposition, dispersal, or release of wildlife, their carcasses, parts, products, or progeny shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements as specified in Rule 68A-9.006(11) and (12), F.A.C.
 - RNW-G #5 All wildlife shall be kept in accordance with the caging and care requirements set forth in Rule 68A-9.006(8)(e) and 68A-6.009, F.A.C.
 - RNW-G #6 Wildlife (except Class I, Class II, beavers, and otters) possessed for rehabilitation purposes may be held no longer than 180 days before it must be released, transferred or euthanized, unless otherwise authorized in accordance with Rule 68A-9.006(12)(a)4., F.A.C.
 - RNW-G #7 Class I wildlife, Class II wildlife, beavers, and otters possessed for rehabilitation purposes may be held no longer than the period specified in Rule 68A-9.006(12)(a), F.A.C. before it must be released, transferred or euthanized, unless otherwise authorized in accordance with Rule 68A-9.006(12)(a)4., F.A.C.
 - RNW-G #8 Wildlife possessed for rehabilitation purposes shall only be considered non-releasable in accordance with standards specified in Rule 68A-9.006(12)(e), F.A.C.
 - RNW-G #9 Permittees who receive any species classified as state threatened or endangered shall notify the FWC Captive Wildlife Section within twenty-four (24) hours of receipt of the wildlife.
 - RNW-G #10 This permit does not authorize the exhibition or sale of wildlife.
 - RNW-G #11 Permittees may utilize up to and no more than ten (10) off-site volunteers. All off-site volunteers must meet the requirements set forth in Rule 68A-9.006(7), F.A.C. and must be approved by the Commission prior to wildlife being housed at an off-site location.
 - RNW-G #14 Permittees or their volunteers shall not enter upon the property of another for the purpose of taking possession of wildlife unless authorized by the owner, lessee, or custodian of the property.
- Explanation of Rights: A person whose substantial interests are affected by FWC's action may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under section 120.569 and 120.57 of Florida Statutes. A person seeking a hearing on FWC's action shall file a petition for hearing with the agency within 21 days of receipt of written notice of the decision. The petition must contain the required information and otherwise comply with section 120.569, Florida Statutes, and the uniform rules of the Florida Division of Administration, 28-106, Florida Administrative Code. If the FWC receives a petition, FWC will notify the permittee.
